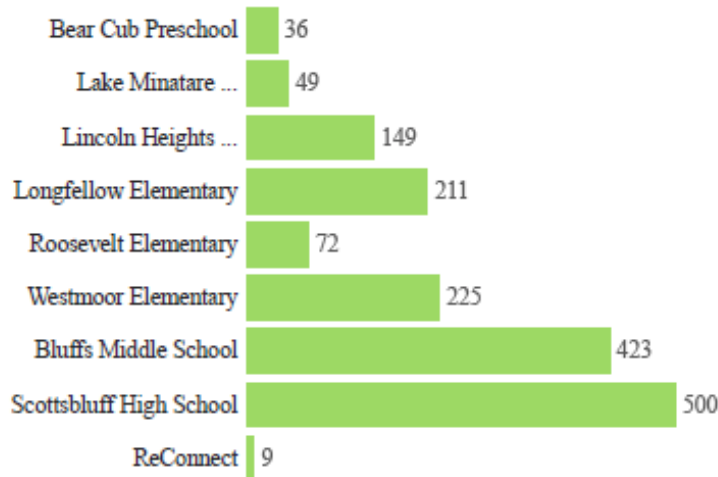

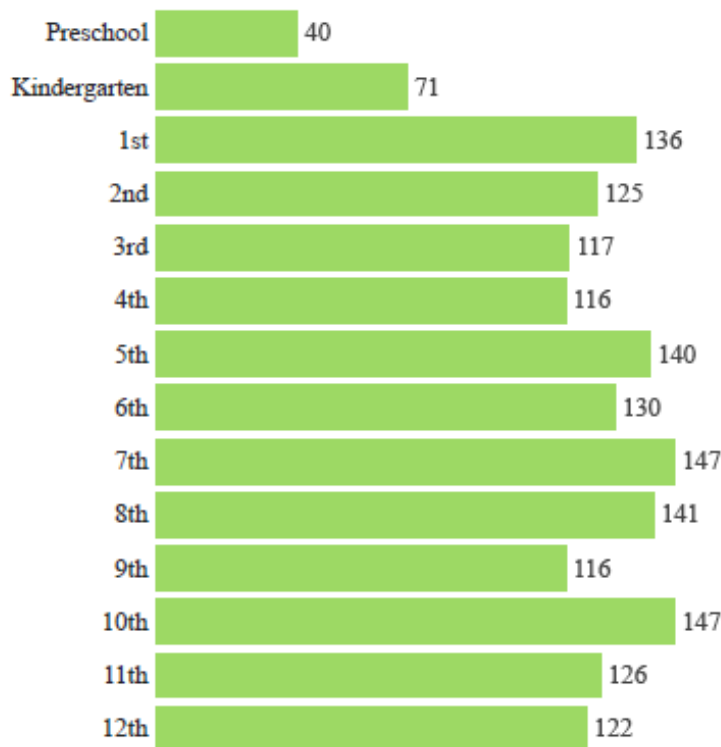


Survey Response Demographics

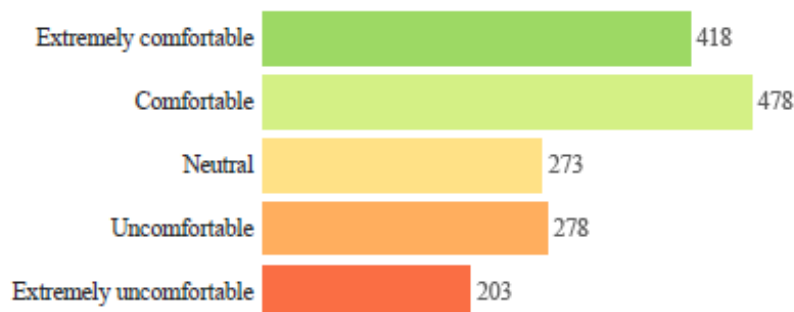

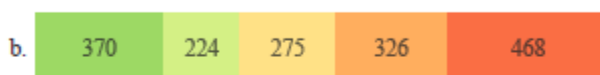

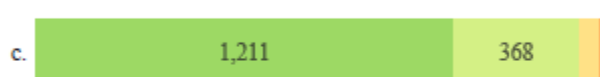
a. Hand sanitizer will be provided in each classroom and frequently used.



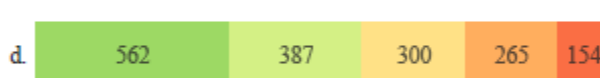
b. Students and staff will be required to wear masks during the school day.

d. Students will be scheduled/grouped to minimize the number of individual students interacting with one another.



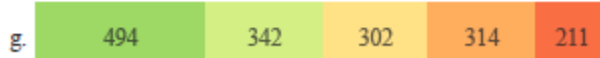
e. School buses will enforce physical distancing between riders and/or run at half capacity.



f. Seating will be arranged to create greater physical distance in the classrooms and lunchrooms.



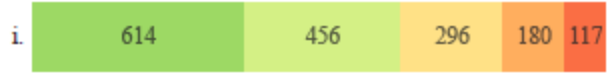
g. Attendance will be limited at any given time to reduce the crowding in the building.



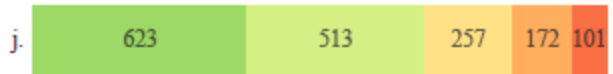
h. Temperature checks will be required before entering the building.



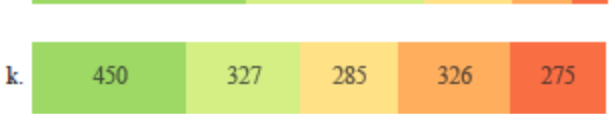
i. Symptom checks will be required before entering the building.



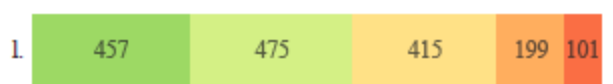
j. Visitors and volunteers will be limited on campus.



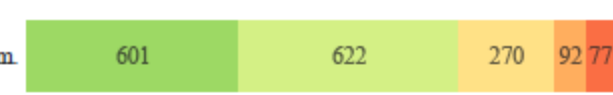
k. Activities that increase heavy breathing, droplet spread, and close physical interactions will be suspended or limited.

n. Protocols will be adjusted based on the severity of cases and spread in the community.



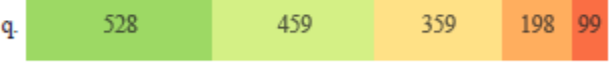
o. Protocols will be adjusted based upon the positive identification of students with COVID-19 in the district.



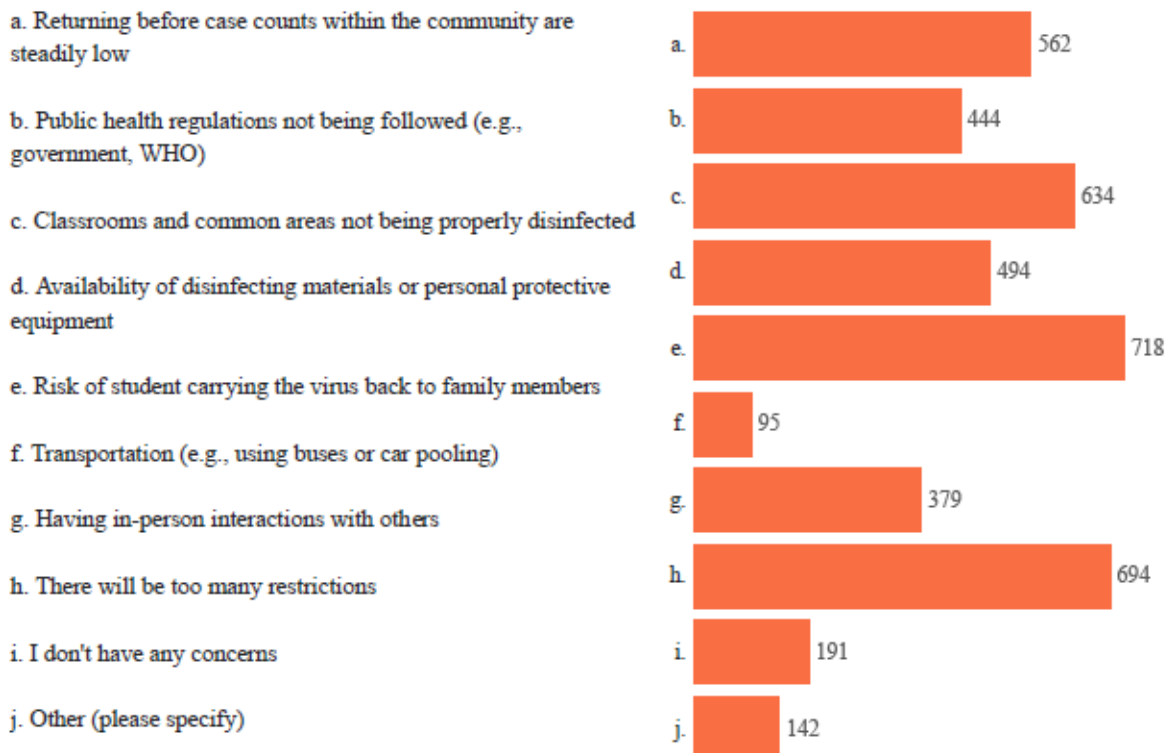
p. Protocols will be adjusted based upon the positive identification of students with COVID-19 in my child's school.



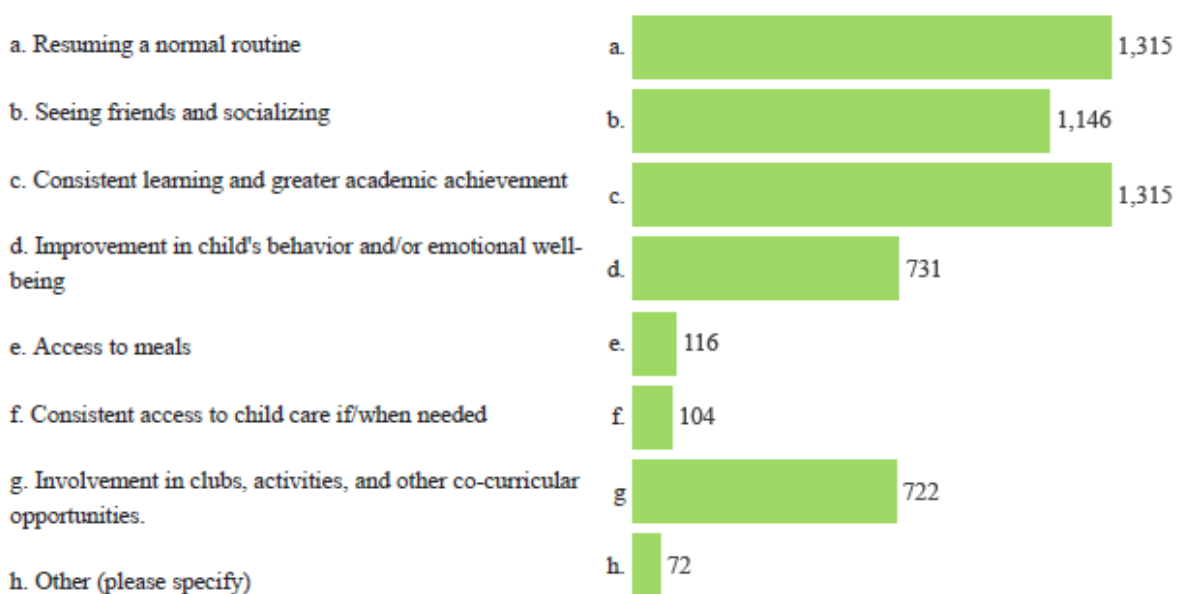
q. Protocols will be adjusted based upon local hospital bed availability.



4. What are your main concerns about sending your student back to school? *Please select all that apply.*

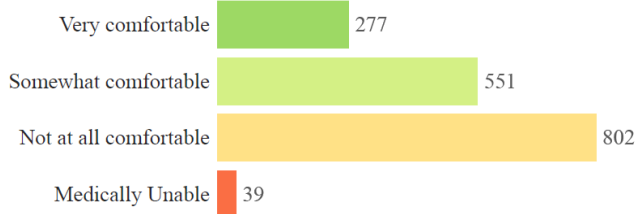


5. What are you looking forward to about your student returning to school? *Please select all that apply.*

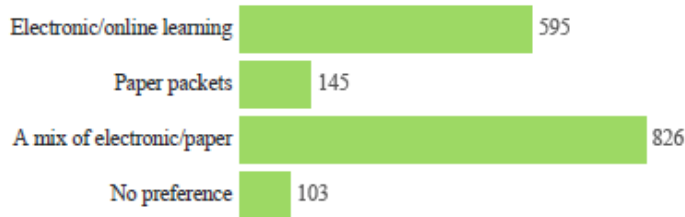

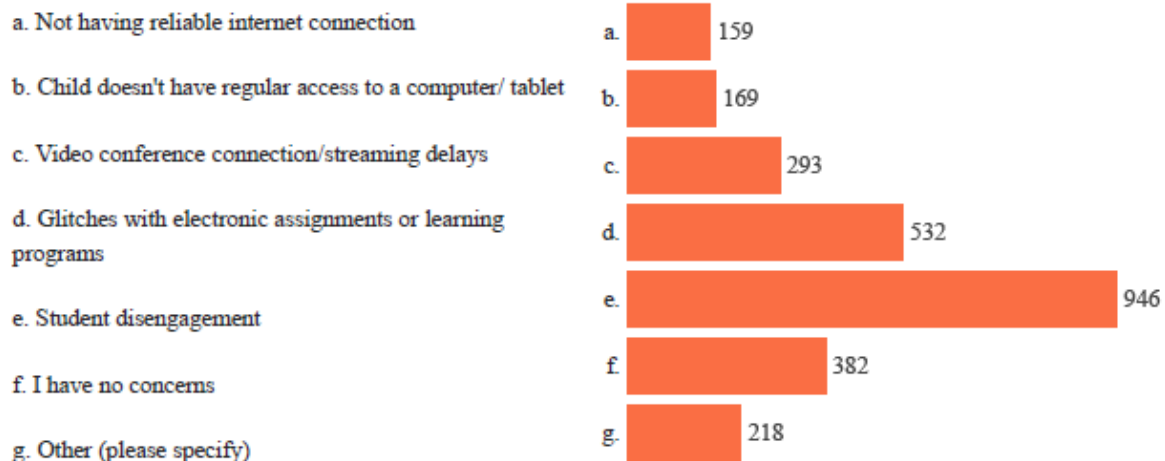
7. What is your preference for accessing materials for remote learning?

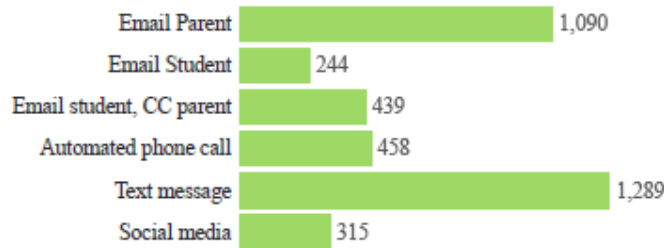

8. What are your concerns regarding technology if your student is learning from home? *Select all that apply.*



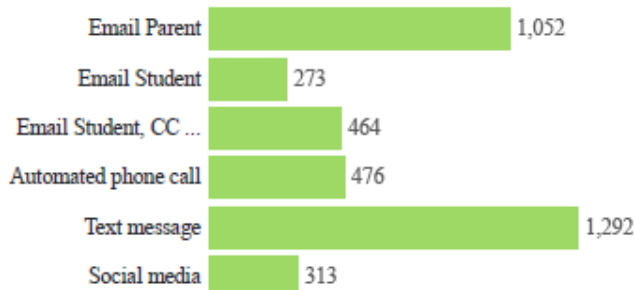

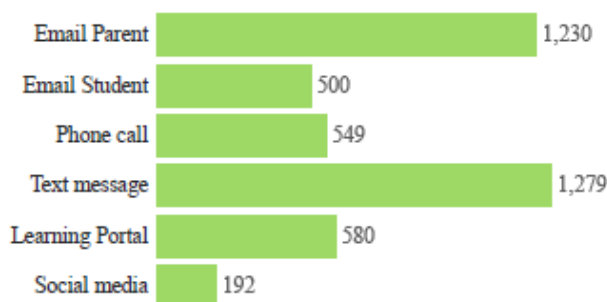
10. What is the best way for you and your student to receive the most up-to-date information from the school? *Select all that apply.*
